DIRECTIONS

To Sewanee Golf Club from I-24 westbound or eastbound:

Take Exit 134 and turn left on Highway 41A. Drive four miles, then bear right on University Ave. Drive one mile, then turn right on Green's View Road and continue .2 mile to the golf club, on the right.
