

WOMEN'S INTRAMURAL DODGEBALL RULES!

- 1. Six players per team start each game. Subs are made between games.**
- 2. Six balls will be placed on the center line. Players start BEHIND the endline and can go for balls on the official's start.**
- 3. At the start, balls must be taken behind the endline before they can be thrown. Failure to take a ball behind the endline means the throw doesn't count.**
- 4. Players hit by a ball that hasn't touched the floor after being thrown are out.**
- 5. If a defender catches a thrown ball, the thrower is out and one player rejoins the defender's team in the order of first out, first in.**
- 6. If a player attempts to catch a ball and drops it, the player is out.**
- 7. The defender may block a ball using another ball. However, the blocked ball is live until it hits the floor, wall, or ceiling. A blocked ball that hits a player (on EITHER team) before hitting the floor, wall, or ceiling gets that player "out."**
- 8. A player may block a live ball, throw the blocking ball down, and then catch the blocked ball to get an opponent out.**
- 9. Any player that leaves the court to avoid being hit is OUT. You may only leave the court to retrieve balls.**
- 10. Any player that steps into the deadzone is OUT.**
- 11. Subs must remain outside the net until the game is over.**
- 12. Players who are out may NOT retrieve balls for their teammates. If they do, the official will reward the ball to the opposition.**
- 12. The leading team may not control all the balls for more than five seconds. A violation will result in the referee stopping play and dividing the balls between both teams.**
- 13. Headshots, resulting from a high thrown ball, result in the thrower being called out. A player hit in the head while ducking or dodging is out. Referees make the final call!**
- 14. Referees have the right to eject players from the game or tournament for unsafe or unsportsmanlike behavior.**
- 15. Play continues until a team is eliminated. One point to the winning team.**
- 16. Balls are then reset on the centerline and a new game begins.**
- 17. When time runs out, both teams get a point for any player remaining.**
- 18. The winner is the team with the most points.**
