Seven All-Conference Awards for 2007

The 2007 Track and Field season ended with several awards at the conference meet. The Tigers had 7 All-Conference athletes and 2 individual champions. Mary Alice Mathison led the way by winning the discus and finishing third in the shot put. Also winning her event was sophomore Rachel Watson with a conference championship in the javelin. Jane Johnson finished second in the javelin to take another all conference award.

On the men's team Sewanee had three all-conference award winners. The Sophomore winners included Tyler Cooney with a third place finish in the pole vault and Allan Long who finished third in the 200m dash. In addition, Hunter Hobson finished second in the 100m.

The women's team finished fourth overall while the men were seventh in the team competition.

Academic Success

The women's track and field program had an outstanding academic semester in the spring. Of the 21 varsity sports at Sewanee, the women's track and field team had the highest team cumulative gpa last semester with a 3.47. The women's team was also named All-Academic by the US Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association. Their team gpa ranked ninth in the nation among NCAA Division 3 schools.

The average gpa for the Sewanee student body is 3.067. "It is great to see that our teams are filled with smart and talented student-athletes" said Head Coach Jeff Heitzenrater
